This year, Hem returns to Copenhagen with a bumper bonanza of creative new designs, extensions to beloved furniture families and – for the first time – exclusive re-editions of long-lost icons.

Unveiled at Palægade 8 for 3daysofdesign, Hem’s wide-ranging selection of upcoming launches includes work by boundary-pushing design luminaries including Philippe Malouin, Faye Toogood, and Marco Campardo, alongside reinvented masterpieces by 20th-century legend Erik Höglund.

From lighting to tableware, furniture and more, Hem’s 2024 collection is extraordinarily diverse in expression, function and materiality, but united by the brand’s characteristic emphasis on colour, exuberance and maverick creativity.

Toto Table Lamps by Fabien Cappello

In Toto, Fabien Cappello has designed a joyful, covetable lamp – an irrepressible burst of colour and light. Its silhouette references an archetypal lamp, with an all-angled shade and a chunky base, but subverts through extreme proportions and unconventional tactility. Toto is entirely covered with textile – a playful extension of the classic lampshade. Material uniformity – coupled with vivid colour and graphic pattern – lends the lamp a cartoonish presence. As does its exaggerated scale; the Toto Large lamp is visually gigantic yet physically light, whereas Toto Small charms with its tidy form and diminutive size. Different colour combinations for shade and base are available in both Toto Large and Medium variants, whereas Toto Small is available in block colours only.
